Pompallier Catholic School:

* Plain gold / silver studs and sleepers only for pierced ears.
No colours and one set only.

Uniforms for girls Y0 - Y6

Girls - Summer Uniform

Culottes (these can be purchased from the school office.) Postie Plus supplies the green short sleeve polo shirt with logo. Green sweatshirt with logo and uniform green sun hat.

Plain black leather Roman sandals (these can be purchased from: Farmers, Warehouse or Postie Plus.)

This uniform is required for Term 1 and Term 4.

Girls - Winter Uniform

Culottes (these can be purchased from the school office.) Postie Plus supply the green short sleeve polo shirt with logo. * Green sweatshirt with logo. Black closed in leather school shoes with buckle/velcro or lace ups — no slip on's or trainers . Girls may wear plain black socks (over the knee socks or black tights are also permissible)

This uniform is required for Term 2 and Term 3.

Hair Girls (Y0—Y8)

No hair dye, highlights or bleach. Hair must be kept clean and tidy. Correct hair ties are bottle green or black. Hair must be kept off the face using plain bottle green or black hair ties, head bands or bobby pins / clips at all times.

* Hairstyles are the same for all year levels

Uniforms for boys Y0 - Y6

Boys - Summer Uniform

Postie Plus supplies uniform grey shorts, the green short sleeve polo shirt with logo, green sweatshirt with logo and uniform green sun hat.

Plain black leather Roman sandals (these can be purchased from: Farmers, Warehouse or Postie Plus.)

This uniform is required for Term 1 and Term 4.

Boys - Winter Uniform

Postie Plus supplies uniform grey shorts, the green short sleeve polo shirt with logo, * green sweatshirt with logo and grey long socks with green band.

Black closed in leather school shoes with velcro or lace ups — no slip on's or trainers .

This uniform is required for Term 2 and Term 3.

Hair Boys (Y0 — Y8)

Haircuts must be tidy, conventional and short.

No tied up hair.

No hair dye, highlights or bleach. No Mohawks (2cm is acceptable), no rat's tails, no shaven bits out of hair and no dreadlocks. Hair at the back should not touch the collar. A buzz cut must be even all over.

Uniform Senior Students (Y7&8)

Green Senior Jackets can be purchased from Aquapulse or at the beginning of the year from the office.

Boys - Summer uniform

Postie Plus supplies white polo shirt with logo, uniform grey shorts and uniform green sunhat.

Plain black leather Roman sandals (these can be purchased from: Farmers, Warehouse or Postie Plus.)

This uniform is required for Term 1 and Term 4.

Girls - Summer uniform

Uniform Skirts can be purchased from the office. Postie Plus supplies white polo shirt with logo and uniform green sunhat.

Plain black leather Roman sandals (these can be purchased from: Farmers, Warehouse or Postie Plus.)

This uniform is required for Term 1 and Term 4.

Boys - Winter Uniform

Same as above and grey long socks with green band from Postie Plus.

Black closed in leather school shoes with velcro or lace ups — no slip on's or trainers .

This uniform is required for Term 2 and Term 3.

Girls - Winter Uniform

Same as above and plain black socks (over the knee socks or black tights are also permissible)

Black closed in leather school shoes with buckle/velcro or lace ups — no slip on's or trainers .

This uniform is required for Term 2 and Term 3.
